

Call for entry 30th Youth Film Festival of Flanders:

Festival medialab: 04/02/2018 - 18/02/2018

1. Organisation

The 29th European Youth Film Festival of Flanders (JEFF) will take place from February 4th till 18th 2018 at various locations in Antwerp, Bruges, Ghent and Courtrai. In the first week the festival organizes school screenings. The second week we open up our cinema and medialab LaboJEFF for families during spring half term. During the year we have an extensive year programme.

The European Youth Film Festival of Flanders is an independent non-profit organisation. The organisation is subsidised by the Flemish Audiovisual Fund (VAF), the provinces of Antwerp and West-Flanders, the cities of Antwerp and Bruges and the European Commission (Media Programme). The festival is a member of the European Children's Film Association (ECFA).

JEFF is the largest screening initiative for quality youth film in Belgium. Besides the screenings, there is broad attention for interactive audiovisual installations (LaboJEFF) and workshops. The festival has a more than local public range and an international character. The aim of the festival is to present and promote European quality films for children and young people.

The medialab LaboJEFF is the interactive playground of the festival. Here our audience can experiment with all kinds of audiovisual installations, creations and techniques. The medialab LaboJEFF is located in Antwerp, our main festival location (http://jeugdfilmfestival.be/nl/archief/festival-event/115).
